Youth LEAD

Youth LEAD is an OzGREEN initiative for young people aged 15 to 25. Youth LEAD is building a network of young leaders who are working in their local community and beyond to build a life-sustaining society.

Youth LEAD begins where other programs finish - with young people learning to be leaders by designing and undertaking their own projects. They become young social entrepreneurs.

THE PROGRAM

The program starts with a three day training and action planning residential workshop involving up to 25 participants. The workshop features skills training in:

- ◆ Ecological footprint assessment and lifestyle analysis,
- ◆ Strategic questioning and critical thinking,
- ◆ Creative thinking, values and visioning
- ◆ Goal setting and action planning for lifestyle changes and projects.

Following the workshop you will be supported through regular e-mail and phone contact, 1 month, 3 month and 6 month follow-up meetings as well as support from local mentors.

You can share your plans, stories and successes through the Youth LEAD email list and interactive website.

WHY GET INVOLVED

Have you ever wanted to do something but aren't sure how you can make a difference or where to start?

No matter what your concerns are, Youth LEAD can help you develop skills and a plan for action to really do something significant.

REGISTRATION

The cost for registration is calculated on a sliding scale from \$50 for unwaged through to \$250 for fully waged. You choose between these amounts depending on your ability to pay. There are also a limited number of fully subsidised places available. NEXT STEPS

After progressing on your project you will have the opportunity to train as a youth-to-youth mentor and a Youth LEAD facilitator. There is also the opportunity to volunteer in OzGREEN programs within Australia and internationally.



OZGREEN

OzGREEN is an independent non-profit organisation established in 1992 and dedicated to addressing critical water issues by enabling informed and active community participation in the care of the world's waters and the building of a life-sustaining society. OzGREEN engages, equips and enables young people and their communities to act in their lives, to care for their rivers and land. Some of OzGREEN's programs include:

MYRiverR: Youth voice, vision and action reversing the decline of river health in the Murray Darling basin.

Living Communities: Community education for sustainable living.

India, Clean Ganges Campaign: Environmental education programs with schools, river priests, media, boatmen and community village water supply program.

East Timor & Papua New Guinea: Sustainable village program involving local communities.
